1. Support to Kew Ong Yah Temple Vehicular Procession – 8th Oct

The Ong Yah Temple in Yishun is celebrating its 100th Anniversary this year. As part of their ongoing celebrations to commemorate the historic even, the Temple Management Committee of Kew Ong Yah Temple arranged for their vehicular procession on 8th October 2024 to make a brief stopover outside our Gurdwara for a simple ceremony to mark and further reinforce the close interaction between different religious organisations as a component of the inter-religious harmony in Singapore. Arrangements were made to formally receive the procession and refreshments and fruits provided to all the participants. The event drew a large crowd from the neighbouring flats and was extremely well received.



2. Visit from Riverside Secondary School – 22nd Oct

About 100 students and teachers from Riverside Secondary School visited Gurdwara Sahib on 22nd Oct from 10am to 12pm. They were given a briefing about Sikhism, its basic tenets and ideology as well as general history of Sikhs in general and Singapore in particular, including history of our Gurdwara. They were treated with simple snacks and food at the Langgar Hall, where the teachers and students partook in roti-making, including tasting their own finished products. The school authorities feedback has been very positive, and they are looking forward to arranging more visits to our Gurdwara.
