Updates on Recent Events

December Overview

1. Significant Sikh events, namely the Guru Gaddi Diwas of Sri Guru Granth Sahib Ji and the Avtar Purab of Guru Nanak Dev Ji were observed last month with great reverence and support of Sangat. It was very nice to see children also participating enthusiastically in these programmes.

Shaheedi Diwas

2. The Saka Sirhind, or the Chhotte Sahibzade Saka commemorates the martyrdom of Guru Gobind Singh Ji's two sons, Zorawar Singh and Fateh Singh. The Shaheedi Sabha (also known as Shaheedi Jod Mela) is a three-day religious congregation held at Gurdwara Sri Fatehgarh Sahib in Punjab, India every year from 24th to 26th Dec. The Shaheedi Sabha commemorates the supreme sacrifice of Guru Ji's sons at the place of their martyrdom. Given that the Singapore Sikh Community, including our Sangat, will be joining the Naam Ras Kirtan Darbar at the Singapore Expo, our Gurdwara Sahib will be organising a one-day program on 29th Dec as
