To commemorate this sacred occasion, a **Chabeel** was organized at our Gurdwara Sahib. From 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., refreshing rose water and Chana Gaphe were served to all passersby as a humble gesture of seva (selfless service) and remembrance.
