1. Day Trip to J.B. on 12th October 2025



A day tour to Johor Bahru (JB) was organized by the Istri Sat Sangh for the ladies on 12 Oct 2025. The group visited the Gurdwara Sahib in JB and also enjoyed Diwali shopping during the trip.

2. Visit by NWCDC Mayor and Students on 13th Oct 2025

Mr. Alex Yam, Mayor of NWCDC, along with 150 students, visited our Gurdwara Sahib as part of a cultural learning initiative aimed at enhancing interfaith and interethnic understanding. The purpose of the visit was to gain a deeper appreciation of the Sikh faith and community.

The visitors were warmly welcomed by the President and Management Committee members. During the session, students were introduced to the origins of the Sikh religion and its basic tenets, including a briefing on our living Guru, Sri Guru Granth Sahib Ji. The presentation also highlighted Sikhism's core principles—spiritual devotion, equality, and social justice—summarized through its “Three Pillars”: Naam

Japna (praying and remembering God), Kirat Karni (earning an honest living), and Vand Chakna (sharing with others).

The session concluded with an engaging question-and-answer segment and a **short** quiz. All guests were then served Guru ka Langar, reflecting the Sikh tradition of equality and community service.

The participants expressed their appreciation for the informative presentation and the opportunity to learn about the values and practices of the Sikh faith.

6. Update on Renovation Works

The following improvements/renovations, as part of the overall improvement of the Gurdwara Infrastructure would be undertaken during the next few months

- Purchase of two metal benches

- Purchase of Floor mats for area outside Gents and Ladies Toilets and around shoe racks
- Improvement of walls and installation of backdrop around the palki sahib
- Replacement of wooden furniture in Langgar hall by stainless steel tables and chairs. Present furniture is 30 years old and wearing off due to age.
- Renewal of cupboards in Office, Library and Spare room.
- Building of storage space on the emergency stairs leading to 1st floor adjacent to Darbar Hall.

7. Building Structure's 5 yearly Inspection

The building's 5-year structural inspection, as required by BCA has been carried out in accordance with **BCA regulations**. We are pleased to share that the inspection was successfully passed, and the **next inspection** will be due in **2030**.
