December Overview

1. Shaheedi Dihara

December is a significant month of deep remembrance for all Sikhs commemorating the supreme sacrifices of Guru Gobind Singh Ji's mother, Mata Gujri, and his four young sons, Chaar Sahibzaade in 1704. As in all our other Gurdwaras, our Gurdwara also commemorated the Shaheedi Hafta through Akhand Paath and other activities. The Management Committee sincerely thanks everyone for their active participation and for the sewa rendered during the Akhand Paath.

2. Rehan Sabai Kirtan

The Rehan Sabai Kirtan will be held at Gurdwara Sahib Yishun on **31 December 2025**. The programme will include the recitation of Rehras Sahib *and* Sukhmani Sahib Path, followed by Kirtan. The Sangat is encouraged to participate wholeheartedly and receive Guru Ji's blessings. Detailed programme information has been shared with the Sangat via e-blast separately.

3. Lohri Festival – 13 January 2026

Lohri marks the passing of the winter solstice and heralds the arrival of a new harvest season. It is one of the most popular festivals in North India, celebrated primarily by Sikhs and Hindus. As in previous years, Lohri will be celebrated at Gurdwara Sahib Yishun on **13 January 2026**. Members of Sangat who wish to reserve slots for goody distribution are requested to inform the Manager so that appropriate space can be made available.

4. Update on Renovation Works

Improvement works will be carried out along the walls around the Palki Sahib between **19th to 21st January** and **26th to 28th January 2026** in terms of wiring and paneling of the area. The work has been staggered to ensure minimal disruption to the main programmes. Any inconvenience cause is much regretted.

The following other renovation works are planned to be carried out over the next few months:

- Replacement of wooden furniture in the Langgar Hall with stainless steel tables and chairs, as the existing furniture is over 30 years old and has worn out

- Renewal of cupboards in the Office, Library, and Bridal Room
- Construction of storage space along the emergency staircase leading from the Darbar Hall to the first floor
