1. Updates on Recent Events (January)

The Sangat celebrated Lohri on 13 January 2026. The Gurdwara witnessed an overwhelming turnout, with members of the Sangat as well as people from other races and religions joining the celebrations. We are immensely grateful for everyone's enthusiastic participation and support.



2.Gurbani Classes (Beginner and Advanced)

In collaboration with the Singapore Missionary Society (SMS), Gurdwara Sahib Yishun has continued its series of Gurbani classes, focusing on meaning, correct pronunciation, and understanding of our Gurbani. The new sessions commenced on 11 January 2026 and are conducted by Professor Jagmanjit Singh of SMS.

Members of the Sangat are encouraged to bring their children so that they too may learn to recite Path meaningfully. Classes for advanced learners (those able to recite Path) are held every Sunday from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm in the Library Room.

3.Yoga Classes

In conjunction with our centennial celebrations, we launched Yoga classes in March 2025. These classes are conducted on a voluntary basis by the dedicated staff of Nikam Guruji Yoga Kutir.

We are pleased to share that two sessions, each comprising 12 classes, have been successfully completed. The response from the Sangat has been very encouraging, and we extend our heartfelt appreciation to the organisers and the Gurdwara Sahib staff.

In support of racial harmony and community integration, these sessions are open to both Sikhs and non-Sikhs, with priority given to members of the Gurdwara Sahib Yishun Sangat.

The new session commenced on 20 January 2026 and has received an excellent response.



4. Renovations

Improvement works are being carried out along the walls surrounding the Palki Sahib between 19–21 January and 26–28 January 2026, involving re-wiring and panelling of the area. The works have been carefully staggered to ensure minimal disruption to the main programmes. Any inconvenience caused is deeply regretted.

In addition, the following renovation works are planned to be carried out over the next few months:

- Replacement of wooden furniture in the Langgar Hall with stainless steel tables and chairs, as the existing furniture is over 30 years old and worn out
- Renewal of cupboards in the Office, Library, and Bridal Room
- Construction of storage space along the **emergency staircase** leading from the Darbar Hall to the first floor
- Replacement of the Palki Sahib with fibre material

The approximate costs for the above works are provided below for the Sangat's information. Members of the Sangat who wish to undertake full or partial sewa are kindly requested to inform the MC members or Giani Angrej Singh. Your support and contributions towards these projects will be greatly appreciated.

Estimated Costs:

- Stainless steel tables (32 nos.) for Langgar Hall: **\$25,000**
- Palki Sahib with side cupboard: **\$15,000**
- Woodwork for Langgar Hall / Office / Bridal Room: **\$25,000**
