1. Updates on Recent Events

a) Mother's Day Celebrations (3rd May)

On-Going Renovation Update

The following works are currently in progress:

a) Upcoming Works in the Coming Months

- Replacement of the Palki Sahib with fibre material – *In Progress*
- Construction of storage space along the emergency staircase leading from the Darbar Hall to the first floor – *KIV*
- Purchase of a 40-foot air-con container for storage of dry provisions – *KIV*

b) Contributions for the Upgrading of Gurdwara's Facilities

Several requests have been received from members of the Sangat to upgrade various Gurdwara facilities. While priority has been given to essential works, funded through renovation contributions collected for this purpose, some members have also stepped forward to offer support for specific needs.
